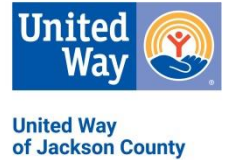


## United Way of Jackson County COVID-19 Fund Individual Services Application -- \$350 limit



If you live in Jackson County, Oregon and need assistance due to conditions caused directly by the COVID-19 pandemic, you may qualify for help from the United Way of Jackson County COVID-19 Fund.

Beginning on March 17, 2020 funds will be distributed to assist with urgent needs, focusing on basic needs and childcare related to COVID-19 work stoppages. Documentation will be required to obtain funds – layoff notices, vendor invoices, utility bills, etc.

To apply for assistance, this form MUST be complete and documentation attached. People will be served on a first come, first served basis. You may email your forms, fax them to 541.773.7042 or drop them through a mail slot at United Way. Incomplete applications or those without documentation will not be processed or followed up on.
